Centenary highlights

One Off - The Big Plastic Count - 9-15 March The Big Plastic Count

JOIN 18,273 people AND TAKE PART IN THE UK'S BIGGEST PLASTIC INVESTIGATION!

Count your plastic for one week from 9 to 15 March.

By taking part in The Big Plastic Count, you'll help gather important evidence to show the true scale of the crisis – and to tell the government we need them to produce less plastic.

Since our last campaign, the UK has elected a new government – one that says it's serious about tackling plastic waste. This is our chance to put their promise to the test.

How to take part:

1. Sign up on their website (they will email you everything you need to get started)
2. Get Counting - join thousands of people across the UK and count all the plastic packaging you throw away for one week . When you're done, submit your count on the website.
3. They will send you your plastic profile - showing what happens to your waste after you bin it.

Do good, get fit with GoodGym Portsmouth - Group runner GoodGym Portsmouth

We are looking for volunteers to come and help us complete physical tasks at different local community projects across Portsmouth. Events Supporter Love4Life

Home Library Service Reading Friend Central, Paulsgrove and Carnegie libraries

A Home Library Service Reading Friend chooses library books based on the interests of the client and then visits them in their home to deliver them. The visit will also include stopping a while for a chat about books or anything else! Books that the client has finished reading will then be returned back to the library.

Online Social Group Volunteer for Trans+ Charity Beyond Reflections

Are you a passionate supporter of the trans+ community? Whether you're trans+ or cis, part of the queer community or a straight ally, Beyond Reflections would love to have you join our team of dedicated volunteers.

As a volunteer host, your role will be to help create a supportive and enjoyable space where our members can chat informally and gain confidence socializing as their authentic selves.

Hen Collection Driver British Hen Welfare Trust - BHWT

As a volunteer driver you'll travel to commercial farms and rehoming points within your designated area. Ideally you will be used to driving some distances towing a trailer or driving a van. You'll also be helping to move and load the crates of hens, so it's a chance to help save thousands of hens from slaughter, literally transporting them from farms to their new lives in retirement.

About the role: Drive to and from commercial farms to rehoming points for an average of 10 rehoming's per year (frequency varies according to region and demand for hens). Help other volunteers collect hens from the farm as well as loading crates into the back of the transport. Positively represent the BHWT in all dealings with supporters.

Knit Hats or Gloves to help Seafarers Stella Maris

Stella Maris is the largest ship-visiting network in the world. We improve the lives of seafarers and fishers through our network of local chaplains and seafarer centres, expert information, advocacy, and spiritual support.

Micro role - Gardening Stamshaw adventure playground

Community Space Volunteer Spark Community Space

Spark Community Space is a local Portsmouth charity supporting those facing loneliness and isolation. Spark started as a lifeline for our founder who herself was experiencing isolation after a life changing brain injury. It has evolved from online coffee mornings to a warm and cozy community hub in the heart of Fratton. We are a community centre, donation-based café and charity shop all in one.

What is the role?

Spark Volunteers help in our Space, making drinks and toasties, serving customers, helping in the charity shop, doing crafts and activities and cleaning/ maintaining the space. We also do events which sometimes require extra people to help at.

Created in April 2017, the De Curci Trust comprises three local schools: Solent Infant School, Solent Junior School and Springfield School (secondary). All three schools are currently rated 'Good' by Ofsted.

The trust seeks a non-executive director (trustee) who ideally has change management, organisational growth, legal/compliance or IT experience to aid potential expansion and to drive continual improvements in school performance. However, applications from candidates with different professional backgrounds, including education, are also welcomed. Board meetings are usually held in Drayton, Portsmouth; occasionally, meetings are on-line.

Befriending, Mentoring & Supporting People

Connections for Life (telephone befriender) Royal Air Forces Association

Our Connections for Life service entails friendship telephone calls from volunteers to beneficiaries within the RAF community who maybe experiencing loneliness, adapting to life after service or just looking for a general chat.

We will provide you with all the necessary training so you can rest assured that you will have all the skills you need.

Literacy Specialist Read Easy

Our Literacy Specialists bring their experience and expertise to provide support to Reading Coaches and assist in running the Reading Coach meetings. The person who takes on this role should have a background in teaching reading/literacy (preferably but not necessarily with adults).

Our volunteer Literacy Specialists feel a real sense of pride in giving practical solutions to their Coordinators and Reading Coaches to give our new Readers the greatest chance of success. You will also attend our management team meetings which occur every couple of months.

Male Mentor A Band of Brothers

We are an award-winning mentoring charity working in Portsmouth and the surrounding area. Our work involves mentoring young men aged 18-25, either already involved in the criminal justice system or in danger of becoming involved. We also work with care leavers and other vulnerable young men, usually on a referral basis.

We are looking for emotionally mature men (around 35+) to help us in this work by becoming mentors.

To become A Band of Brothers mentor, you will first be invited to participate in a 6 week Mentor Induction Training (MIT) programme, meeting for up to an hour a week with one of our fully trained mentors. In this process, you'll find out more about us and what we do. If you then feel you'd like to train as an abob mentor, you will undertake a weekend course (currently online) that will teach you the abob style of mentoring.
